

**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' SECOND MOTION FOR SUMMARY  
JUDGMENT**


Before the Court is the second motion for summary judgment filed on December 17, 2021, by Defendants Wenjest Corporation d/b/a Williams Grocery and Piedmont Citizen, Jeffrey Don Williams, and Ron and Donaya Hau, and the response in support filed on January 5, 2022, by Defendant John Mike Simpson. These Defendants contend that that the Plaintiff has failed to present sufficient evidence to support its claims of defamation, tortious interference with business relations, and false light. These three claims all relate to alleged defamatory statements made by the Defendants concerning the Plaintiff. The Defendants also contend that the Plaintiff is not the proper party in interest and that this action was brought outside of the statute of limitations. The Plaintiff filed an objection to this motion on January 4, 2022, and the Defendants filed a reply on January 21, 2022.

The Court previously directed the Plaintiff to file a supplemental response to the motion for summary and to specifically identify in its response the alleged defamatory

statements, the identity of the person(s) who made (published) the statements, and when the statements were made. The Plaintiff filed its supplemental response with exhibits on April 25, 2022, but did not provide the details sought by the Court or that is needed to maintain the claims of defamation, tortious interference with business relations, and false light. In particular, the "Plaintiff's Supplement to Statements of Additional Facts Bearing on Summary Judgment," beginning on page 7 of the supplemental response, does not specify a single defamatory statement. The Plaintiff continues to simply allege generally that the Defendants engaged in tortious activities without the specificity that would allow the Court to evaluate the Plaintiff's claims against the Defendants' motion for summary judgment. For example, paragraph 3, reads as follows: "The Piedmont Citizen consistently published false and defamatory articles about Plaintiff and its principal 'sometime after 2012' to put a 'harsh light on Boevers' activities,' including online publications." This statement provides no specificity as to the content of any of the articles and does not identify any statement in any article that was false. Also, for example, paragraph 12, reads in part as follows: "Williams enlisted the aid of Ron and Donya Hau to spread false and defamatory information, including the defamatory information posted online by Fina and Burris using false identities..." Again, this statement provides no specificity as to the content of the materials posted online or what statement in the online posting was false.

After consideration of all of the filings and evidentiary materials related to the motion for summary judgment, the Court finds that the Defendants have demonstrated that no controversy exists as to the material facts and that the Defendants are entitled to summary judgment as a matter of law. **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Defendants' Second Motion for Summary Judgment is **GRANTED**. The hearing on this motion scheduled for Wednesday, July 20, 2022, is stricken.
